About the foundation



Women Empowerment

The foundation provides periodic trainings & workshops to educate our artisans in different forms of weaving. Many of our weavers have turned into small scale entrepreneurs with the support of the foundation. The foundation has transformed the lives of nearly 15000 women till now.

ACTIVITIES

- More than 15000 Female artisans are working with the foundation thereby earning a living for themselves & their families.
- The foundation provides free carpet weaving education for women enabling them to learn this art & adapt it as a mean of living.
- Well-equipped centres have been established for carpet making, the women weavers have the option to weave from their home at their own comfortable time.







Keeping Community Healthy

A healthy mind resides in a healthy body.

The access to basic health care is a fundamental right that is still inaccessible to a majority of our rural population. The foundation with its team of experienced doctors periodically organises health camps, eye check-ups & general awareness camps in the villages & thousands of rural people regularly benefit from these camps.









ACTIVITIES

- Eye Check-up Camps are periodically held in villages for the rural people. Here Our team of doctors examine the eyes of patients & provide medicines &/or spectacles depending on the diagnosis. Many patients have been successfully operated for cataract too.
- Free Medicine Distribution Camps are held for the underprivileged people where the foundation team distributes medicines free of cost after their basic health check-up.
- Health Awareness Programs are conducted in forms of rallies, street plays & camps to create awareness towards various deadly diseases, their prevention & cure.
- We cover 4 state in all over India.

Shaping The Future

Education is a necessity not a luxury.

Our future lies in our children & the foundation works dedicatedly in providing education to the rural children. The foundation awards scholarships to the meritorious students to ease their quest for higher studies, especially girls by awarding them 10000 INR to pursue their passion for studies.

- Scholarship program for meritorious students belonging to below poverty line families.
- Collaboration with ICICI Foundation to provide 3 months job-oriented residential training totally free of cost including one meal per day.
- Establishment of B R International School at Dharampur,
 Valsad (It is the only CBSE affiliated school in that region)
